I request Great Eastern Resort Management Inc. issue a season skiing/snowboarding pass to me. I understand this Season Pass purchase is nonrefundable and nontransferable.

_____The RFID Season Pass purchased is for the personal use only of the person whose photo (on file) and name appears on the RFID Season Pass. I agree that the RFID Season Pass will not be sold, given, loaned, traded or assigned to another person, or reproduced in any way whatsoever. The use or attempted use of a pass by someone other than the pass holder themselves is theft of service, and will be handled accordingly. I acknowledge that the RFID Season Pass is, and shall remain the property of Massanutten. Upon violation of the above, my RFID Season Pass will be revoked without a refund.

_____ I must have my RFID Season Pass card with me to be entitled to use the lifts and ski/snowboard at Massanutten.

_____ I agree (1) to carry my RFID Season Pass card in a left side, zipped pocket between 24" to 48" above the snow surface. No other items (cell phone, credit card, coins, or metal wrapper) should be carried in the same pocket as the RFID card, (2) not to punch any holes in the RFIC card as it will destroy the antenna, (3) to refrain from any misconduct or reckless skiing/riding, acknowledging that the Season Pass may be revoked without refund, (4) to read and follow "Your Responsibility Code", and (5) I am purchasing/using the privilege (not the right) to ski/snowboard at Massanutten and this privilege may be withdrawn in Massanutten's sole discretion

_____ Should I lose my RFID Season Pass; I will notify the Ski Office immediately. **I can replace the season pass one time, and will be charged a non-refundable processing fee of \$20.**

_____ Massanutten does not guarantee the pass holder the opening and closing dates of the 2022/2023 winter season, nor a continuous daily operation of all its lifts throughout the season.

Season Pass expires at the end of the 2022/2023 ski season.

Massanutten does not permit riding lifts, skiing, snowboarding, or snow tubing with child carriers of any kind. All ski and snowboard equipment must have metal edges.

I agree that any legal dispute arising out of this agreement, my use of the equipment, or my participation in the sport shall be submitted to mediation prior to filing a lawsuit. Only after mediation has been conducted may a lawsuit then be filed. Any such lawsuit shall be filed in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Virginia or the Circuit Court of Rockingham County, Virginia, even if another venue is more convenient. I agree that if any portion of this Agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

Skiing/snowboarding is an inherently dangerous sport which can result in personal injury, death, or property damage. Observe "Your Responsibility Code" at all times. If you are not willing to accept the above statement, you do not have permission to ski/snowboard this area.

"YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE"

Skiing and snowboarding can be enjoyed in many ways. At ski areas you may see people using alpine, snowboard, telemark, cross-country, or other specialized ski equipment, such as that used by disabled or other skiers. Regardless of how you decide to enjoy the slopes, always show courtesy to others and be aware that there are elements of risk in skiing that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Observe the code listed below and share with other skiers the responsibility for a great skiing experience.

- Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
- People ahead or downhill of you have the right-of-way. You must avoid them.
- Stop only where you are visible from above and do not restrict traffic.
- Look uphill and avoid others before starting downhill or entering a trail.
- You are responsible to prevent runaway equipment.
- Read and obey all signs, warnings, and hazard markings.
- Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- You must know how and be able to load, ride, and unload lifts safely. If you need assistance, ask the lift attendant.
- Do not use lifts or terrain when impaired by alcohol or drugs.
- If you are involved in a collision or incident, share your contact information with each other and a ski area employee.

KNOW THE CODE. IT'S YOUR RESPONSIBILITY.
